Eric Townsend: Welcome everyone to Family Forum.

- We are sad to report that Justin Bayliss has resigned as Director of LTC, we wish him all the best.
- The County Administrator Ian Coyle is actively looking for a replacement. I will be the Administrator of Record in the interim.
- Mr. Frank Bassett will be coming back for a short period in a consulting capacity. He will be looking at our processes and giving us feedback in how to improve. We look forward to his presence in the facility again.

Updates:

- COVID-19
 - We had 6-7 residents positive about 3-4 weeks ago. We currently have no residents testing positive.
 - We have 3 staff out of work right now due to COVID- 19.
 - We continue the vaccine clinics for all residents and staff.
 - 178 Residents/167 are boosted/3 residents declined all vaccines.
 - 63% of staff is boosted.
- Central Services staff is currently here painting and doing repairs on each Neighborhood.
- The LCCNR was a 4 Star facility, we have dropped down to a 3 Star.
 - It is based on a calculation of:
 - Health Inspection
 - Quality Measures
 - Staffing
 - Based on a calculation error it has put us down to a 3 Star. We anticipate our STAR rating improving sometime in October/November.

Department Updates:

- Intern (Kate) last day with us was at the end of July.
- Resident Council meetings continue, we look forward to bringing back the Resident Rep Committee very soon.
- We are being much more efficient in our paperwork, making some good improvements in our processes.

- We remain pretty steady across all neighborhoods.

Kim Kavanagh/Activities

- Patty (Dietary Supervisor) and I are trying to get the Food Committee back together again. This is where we meet as a group with Residents and review the food menu's and offerings.
