TERMS AND CONDITIONS WHICH MAY BE IMPOSED

- Contact with Pre-Trial Services as determined by the Court or pre-trial staff.
- Pre-Trial Supervision with only the following limited conditions:
- Do not violate any provision of local, state or federal law and report all contact with law enforcement immediately
- Personally appear on this case in all proceedings, on time, when required to appear by law or further order of the said Court
- Immediately notify Livingston County Pre-Trial Services of any changes to contact information
- Do not leave Livingston and/or _____ County/COUNTIES, State of New York without the consent of the Court or Livingston County Pre-Trial Services
- Obey any orders of protection
- No operation of motor vehicle (unless possession of a valid driver's license)
- Obey curfew set by the Court.
- No use of illegal drugs, marijuana, or consumption of alcoholic beverages. You will waive your Constitutional Rights and will submit to random chemical/alcohol tests upon the request of the Pre-Trial Services to monitor compliance with release conditions and as a tool for the Court to predict and reduce pre-trial conduct. (Defendant shall not be responsible for payment of any testing requirement.)
- Refrain from possession of any handguns, pistols, revolvers, rifles, shotguns, muzzleloaders, or any other firearms

REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS

- Defendants in County Court should be directed to report to Pre-Trial Services in person, immediately following their appearance.
- Defendants in County Court who are released from jail AFTER Probation is closed should contact Probation by telephone for reporting instructions. When doing so leave your name, a phone number where you can be reached and the address where you are staying.
- Those in local court should be directed to immediately call and leave a message with Pre-Trial Services and await reporting instructions.
- All non-compliance will be submitted to the Court for review.
